5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$13,886,334.88
6 (\$3,236,707.40 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE
7 OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
8 PROTECTION AND \$10,649,627.48 RESULTING FROM A
9 CLEAN-UP OF CITY ALL-YEARS SUBFUNDS) FOR THE
10 DUVAL COUNTY SHORE PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO
11 REIMBURSE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE PROJECT
12 COST FOR ALREADY COMPLETED TASKS FUNDED BY
13 CITY THROUGH PAYMENTS TO CONSTRUCT THE 16-17
14 DUNE REPAIRS AND ADVANCE PAYMENT OF FUNDS TO
15 THE U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND UPCOMING
16 BEACH MANAGEMENT TASKS, AS WELL AS PROVIDING
17 FOR A CLEAN-UP OF ALL-YEARS SUBFUNDS AS
18 REQUIRED BEFORE THE ERP GO-LIVE DATE, BOTH AS
19 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-017; APPROVING AND
20 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND
21 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND
22 DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE
23 STANDARD GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF
24 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
25 AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR
26 OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION
27 MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
28 PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
2 indicated sums from the accounts listed in subsection (a) to the
3 accounts listed in subsection (b):

10 (c) Explanation of appropriation.

11 The appropriation above comprises \$3,236,707.40 in grant
12 funds from the State of Florida Department of
13 Environmental Protection and \$10,649,627.48 resulting
14 from a clean-up of City all-years subfunds.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The Duval County Shore Protection
16 Project (the "Project") is a cooperatively funded program amongst
17 the federal government through the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers
18 (USACE), the State of Florida through the Florida Department of
19 Environmental Protection (FDEP), and the City of Jacksonville (the
20 "City"). The focus of the Project is the re-nourishment of the
21 beaches in Duval County. Re-nourishment projects are accomplished
22 by need and therefore can fluctuate because of erosion rates and
23 hurricanes. These projects usually occur in approximately five-year
24 intervals. The purpose of this legislation is to appropriate FDEP
25 funds to reimburse City's participation in i) the Project cost for
26 already completed tasks funded by City through payments to
27 construct the 16-17 dune repairs and advance payment of funds to
28 USACE and ii) upcoming beach management tasks. In addition, the
29 legislation also includes a clean-up of these all-years subfunds as
30 required before the ERP go-live date.

1 **Section 3. Approving and authorizing execution of**
2 **Standard Grant Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor,
3 or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby
4 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City,
5 the Standard Grant Agreement between the State of Florida
6 Department of Environmental Protection and the City of
7 Jacksonville, a copy of which has been placed **on file** with the
8 Office of Legislative Services.

9 **Section 4. Departmental Oversight.** The Engineering and
10 Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works
11 shall oversee the Project.

12 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
