BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Execution of Interlocal Agreement authorized. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Interlocal Agreement between Duval County First Responder (the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) and Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)), in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"), in compliance with Section 365.179, Florida Statutes.

Purpose. The purpose of this legislation is Section 2. to authorize the execution of the Agreement. Section 365.179, Florida Statutes, requires direct radio communications between 9-1-
