6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,600,000.00 FROM
7 TWO COUNTYWIDE PROJECTS, THE ROADWAY SIGN
8 STRIPE AND SIGNAL PROJECT AND THE COUNTYWIDE
9 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, TO TWO NEW
10 SPECIFIC PROJECTS, THE PEARL STREET AND 44TH
11 STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND
12 THE UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD AND JACK ROAD
13 PROJECT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-025; AMENDING
14 THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
15 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO
16 REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECTS ENTITLED
17 "ROADWAY SIGN STRIPE AND SIGNAL" AND
18 "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP & BRIDGE REHAB -
19 INTERSECTIONS" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
20 PROJECTS ENTITLED "PEARL STREET - 44TH STREET
21 INTERSECTION" AND "UNIVERSITY BLVD -
22 UNIVERSITY BLVD & JACK RD INTERSECTION IMP;"
23 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
28 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
29 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

6 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

7 The funding above is a transfer of debt management funds
8 from two countywide projects, the Roadway Sign Stripe and
9 Signal Project and the Countywide Intersection
10 Improvements Project, to the construction costs of two
11 new specific projects, the Pearl Street and 44th Street
12 Intersection Improvements Project and the University
13 Boulevard and Jack Road Project.

14 **Section 2. Purposes.** The Pearl Street and 44th Street
15 Intersection Improvements Project is for the design and
16 construction of a traffic signal and overhead fiber interconnect
17 along East 44th Street between Pearl Street and Main Street. The
18 design will include special emphasis crosswalks with upgraded ADA
19 compliant ramps, pedestrian signal phasing, and extended left-turn
20 bays on Pearl Street. The University Boulevard and Jack Road
21 Project is for the design and construction of a traffic signal and
22 overhead fiber interconnect along University Boulevard between
23 Merrill Road and Fort Caroline Road. The design will include
24 special emphasis crosswalks with upgraded ADA compliant ramps,
25 pedestrian signal phasing, and coordination with both Arlington
26 Community Redevelopment Area and Jacksonville University.

27 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being
28 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
29 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
30 reduce funding for the projects entitled "Roadway Sign Stripe and
31 Signal" and "Countywide Intersection Imp & Bridge Rehab -

1 Intersections” and provide funding for the projects entitled “Pearl
2 Street - 44th Street Intersection” and “University Blvd - University
3 Blvd & Jack Rd Intersection IMP.” The projects are more fully
4 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as
5 **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as “Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP,
6 January 6, 2020 - TEU” and incorporated herein by this reference.
7 The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
8 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
9 the best interests of the community because such deferral will
10 result in unnecessary delay in the installation of traffic
11 infrastructure in critical areas. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c),
12 *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires the
13 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at
14 the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section.
15 This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-
16 E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program
17 approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and
18 effect.

19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor’s signature.
