Background Information: State law requires the City Council (acting in its capacity as the county commission) to approve change in polling locations. The Supervisor of Elections locates polling places for accessibility and convenience to the voters of the precinct, within the limits of available and willing facilities.

Policy Impact Area: Polling place locations

Fiscal Impact: The Supervisor of Elections Office estimates that establishment of a new precinct will cost \$1,764 for printing and mailing of approximately 1,500 new voter registration cards and \$2,152 per election for staffing (at the current pay rate for 9 personnel). The cost of printing and mailing approximately 40,000 voter registration cards to voters affected by the precinct location changes is estimated at \$47,040. There are no new capital costs and no additional operational funding is being requested, as sufficient capacity exists in the SOE's current budget.
