6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$34,435.00 IN  
7 UNALLOCATED/TRUST FUND AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES  
8 FROM THE RENEW ARLINGTON CRA TRUST FUND TO  
9 SALARIES PART-TIME (IN THE AMOUNT OF  
10 \$30,000.00) MEDICARE TAX (IN THE AMOUNT OF  
11 \$435.00) AND ADVERTISING AND MARKETING FOR THE  
12 COMPLIANCE GRANT PROGRAM (IN THE AMOUNT OF  
13 \$4,000.00), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-041;  
14 APPROVING PART-TIME HOURS, AS INITIATED BY  
15 R.C. 20-066; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
20 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
21 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

29 The appropriation above comprises \$30,435.00 of  
30 Unallocated/Trust Fund Authorized Expenditures from the  
31 Renew Arlington CRA Trust Fund to Salaries Part-Time and

1 Medicare Tax, as well as \$4,000.00 from the same source  
2 for advertising and marketing of the Compliance Grant  
3 Program.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** Ordinance 2019-239-E authorized the  
5 creation of the Renew Arlington (RA) Zoning Overlay, and Ordinance  
6 2019-879 is currently in the process of amending the Zoning Code to  
7 create a consolidated review process within the Planning &  
8 Development Department for properties within the RA Zoning Overlay  
9 that are out of conformance with overlay guidelines for fences,  
10 landscaping/landscape buffers, and signage. In order to assist with  
11 the design, development, review, and inspection of construction  
12 projects for the Renew Arlington Mandatory Compliance Grant Program  
13 offered to property owners/applicants located within the Renew  
14 Arlington Community Redevelopment Area (CRA), the Office of  
15 Economic Development (OED) will hire a part-time professional  
16 landscape designer to be funded by available Unallocated Plan  
17 Authorized Expenditures from the Renew Arlington CRA budget.  
18 Ordinance 2018-555-E revised the City's Community Redevelopment  
19 Agencies, including amendments to Chapter 106, *Ordinance Code*. In  
20 compliance with Section 106.341, *Ordinance Code*, a CRA board may  
21 not transfer funds within the Administrative Expenditures Category  
22 without Council approval. The purpose of this legislation is to  
23 approve the appropriation of funds for the position and additional  
24 funding for advertising and marketing of the Compliance Grant  
25 Program. The funding will allow for up to 400 part-time hours; the  
26 landscape designer will report to the Executive Director of the  
27 OED.

28 **Section 3. Approval of Part-time hours.** There are  
29 hereby approved the part-time hours more fully described in R.C.  
30 20-066, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by  
31 this reference.



1           **Section 4.           Effective Date.**   This ordinance shall become  
2 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
3 without the Mayor's signature.
