7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00
8 (\$100,000.00 CONTRIBUTION FROM A PRIVATE
9 SOURCE AND \$100,000.00 CITY MATCH FROM THE
10 RESERVE FOR FEDERAL PROGRAMS) TO IMPLEMENT AN
11 ANTI-VAPING HEALTH AWARENESS EDUCATIONAL
12 CAMPAIGN FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 ON
13 THE CONSEQUENCES OF VAPING, AS INITIATED BY
14 B.T. 20-042; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
15 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2021; PROVIDING FOR
16 OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICE;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
22 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
23 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

31 The appropriation above comprises of a contribution from

1 a private source in the amount of \$100,000.00 and a City
2 match of \$100,000.00 from the Reserve for Federal
3 Programs to the Public Affairs Office to implement an
4 anti-vaping health awareness educational campaign for
5 children under the age of 18 on the consequences of
6 vaping.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to provide funding to implement an anti-vaping health
9 awareness educational campaign for children under the age of 18 on
10 the consequences of vaping. The issue of vaping by young people
11 under the age of 18 has been assigned by Council President Wilson
12 to a Special Committee on the Opioid Epidemic.

13 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
14 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover through
15 fiscal year 2021.

16 **Section 4. Public Affairs Office oversight.** The Public
17 Affairs Office will oversee the request for proposal to obtain a
18 responsive bidder to perform the anti-vaping health awareness
19 educational campaign for children under the age of 18.

20 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
