## RESOLUTION 2020-75

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING MIKE MAYCOTT FOR SAVING A LIFE WITH HIS USE OF CPR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jacksonville resident Mike Maycott earned an associate's degree from the University of North Florida and worked as a customer service manager for a supermarket until starting his own custom cabinetry and woodworking shop - Planked Woodworking - in 2012; and

WHEREAS, in late December of 2019 Mr. Maycott was installing his handiwork at a job site when Eric Rupertis, a plumber for Turner Plumbing Company, also working at the site, suffered a serious medical event and stopped breathing. Mr. Maycott immediately sprang into action and applied his CPR training to Mr. Rupertis, keeping his heart beating and his lungs processing oxygen for 20 minutes until medical responders arrived on the scene and transported him to the hospital; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rupertis, in dire condition when he reached the Mayo Clinic, was revived by the skilled professionals at Mayo and made a remarkable recovery in just a few days thanks to "breath of life" provided by Mr. Maycott; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and commends Mike Maycott for his quick thinking and brave action in providing CPR to a fellow workman in need, saving the life of Eric Rupertis by his actions. The Council extends its gratitude for his heroism and his concern for his fellow man.
