A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY JACKSONVILLE OF APPROVING THE ADAPTATION ACTION AREA WORKGROUP REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS, DATED NOVEMBER 2019; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville implemented the State of Florida 2015 Peril of Flood legislation (Section 163.3178(2)(f)2, Florida Statute) by designating an area within the City that experiences coastal flooding due to extreme high tides and storm surge and is vulnerable to the impacts of sea level rise as the Adaptation Action Area (AAA) in the Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in 2017 the Planning and Development Department proposed and the City Council adopted the AAA into the Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and committed to establishing a Workgroup to review existing programs and policies to determine the need and appropriate timing for additional and financially feasible responses to the effects of coastal flooding within the AAA; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department established the Workgroup and from February through August 2019 the Workgroup held public meetings and learned about and evaluated existing policies and regulations related to infrastructure, land

development, utilities, and emergency management and formulated a series of recommendations; and WHEREAS, in November 2019 the Adaptation Action Area Workgroup issued its Report and Recommendations; now, therefore BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Approval of Report and Recommendations. The City Council hereby recognizes and approves the Adaptation Action Area Workgroup Report and Recommendations dated November 2019, On File with the City Council Legislative Services Division.
