Bill Summary: The bill approves the closure and abandonment of a Jacksonville Heights unopened & unimproved right-of-way established in Plat Book 5, Page 93, as described in Exhibit 1. The closure and abandonment is subject to the completion of a hold harmless covenant between the City and the applicant.

Background Information: The applicant, Robert Kurt Russell, is applying to close the applicant's half of a right of way to accommodate a proposed auto dealership. There is no infrastructure within this right-of-way; and no City, State or other agencies object to this closure request.

Policy Impact Area: Jacksonville rights-of-way

Fiscal Impact: The applicant has paid \$2,091.00 in closure application fees, which has been deposited in the General Fund.
