**Bill Summary:** This bill appropriates \$551,839.39 from the Federal Forfeitures Trust Fund for the purchase of covert/specialized law enforcement equipment and specialized computer equipment, and a contribution of \$150,000.00 to First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. for the funding of the Sheriff's Gun Bounty Program, as initiated by B.T. 13-038.
