(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is from the portion of the Tree Protection and Related Expenses Trust Fund generated from tree mitigation requirements in Part 12 of the Zoning Code (15F) for a Level 3 Tree Planting project in Huguenot Park.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for a Level 3 Tree Planting submitted by the Public Trust Environmental Legal Institute for the planting of trees in Huguenot Park. Huguenot Park lost many trees during recent storms and would benefit from a more robust canopy. Both the new campsites and the old campsites would benefit from increased wind protection and shade. The trees will provide habitat for native species within Huguenot Park and benefit thousands of park visitors. The planting will take place in four phases, with each planting phase happening each successive winter/spring; the number of trees in each phase will be limited to 100.

**Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, the Tree Planting Program (Level 3) Grant Agreement between the Public Trust Environmental Legal Institute and the City of Jacksonville, a copy of which is has been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

**Section 4. Oversight.** The Mowing and Landscape Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
