5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE 6 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION 7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, Α DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANT BETWEEN 8 9 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP), 10 ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY 11 AND ΤO EFFECUTATE THE PURPOSES OF THE RESTRICTIVE 12 COVENANT, FOR PROPERTY CURRENTLY OCCUPIED BY 13 14 THE CITY'S ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES 15 FACILITY AT 2020 FOREST STREET, RE #089868-16 0100, SO AS TO PLACE ENVIRONMENTAL 17 RESTRICTIONS ON THE SITE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 18

WHEREAS, though environmental conditions due to the discharge of petroleum products on the property currently occupied by the City's Animal Care and Protective Services facility at 2020 Forest Street, RE #089868-0100, have been remediated, soil and groundwater impacts remain below various paved areas and areas covered by two feet of clean soils; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has agreed to regulatory closure of the site pending the approval and placement of a Declaration of Restrictive Covenant (DRC) on the property; and

30 WHEREAS, the DRC does not prevent future work on or 31 modification of the site but does require proper regulatory 1 handling of activities that will go below the cap or encounter 2 contaminated soils or groundwater and does require a documented 3 annual inspection of the conditions to ensure the cap is being 4 maintained; and

5 WHEREAS, the DRC can be removed in the future if the site is 6 cleaned up completely;

7 WHEREAS, regulatory closure of the site is being done to avoid 8 costly remediation efforts and to ensure that various existing 9 infrastructure and landscaping does not have to be disturbed or 10 removed and replaced due to soil and groundwater impacts beneath 11 them; now therefore

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 Section 1. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby 14 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary 15 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, 16 a Declaration of Restrictive Covenant, in substantially the same 17 form placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services, and any other documents necessary to effectuate the purposes of the 18 19 DRC, so as to allow the City to place environmental restrictions on 20 the site.

21 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 23 without the Mayor's signature.
