## NCSPHS AMENDMENT

The Neighborhoods, Community Services, Public Health & Safety Committee offers the following amendment to File No. 2020-63:

- (1) On page 1, line 17, after "ORDINANCE;" <u>insert</u> "AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "FREEDOM PARK";";
- (2) On page 2, line 25<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, <u>insert</u> a new Section 4 to read as follows:

"Section 4. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Freedom Park." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay in the creation of the park. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

- (3) Renumber remaining Sections accordingly;
- (4) Attach Exhibit 2 attached hereto, which attaches a copy of the CIP project information sheet;
- (5) On **page 1**, **line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
