The City portion of the QTI is 20 percent of the award, or \$1,200 per new qualified job created, up to a maximum of \$138,000. The QTI award will be payable after the average wage and job created is verified by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity over the proposed six year payout, beginning in 2021.
- The project has a positive ROI of 2.65 for the City of Jacksonville.
