5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT;
6 APPROPRIATING \$1,401,975.00 FROM THE
7 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, WITH NO CITY
8 MATCH, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
9 2019 REGIONAL CATASTROPHIC PREPAREDNESS GRANT
10 PROGRAM ("RCPGP") TO FUND TWO FULL-TIME
11 PROGRAM MANAGERS, TRAINING CLASSES, EXERCISE
12 WORKSHOPS, AND THE PURCHASE OF NON-CAPITAL
13 OFFICE SUPPLIES AND OPERATING SUPPLIES, AS
14 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-053; AUTHORIZING THE
15 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
16 SECRETARY TO ACCEPT, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
17 CITY, THE RCPGP AWARD DOCUMENTS BETWEEN THE U.
18 S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND THE
19 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY
20 OVERSIGHT BY THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE
21 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; APPROVING
22 POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 20-093;
23 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
28 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
29 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

5 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

6 The funding above is a grant award from the U. S.
7 Department of Homeland Security, with no local match, for
8 the Fiscal Year 2019 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness
9 Grant Program ("RCPGP") to fund two full-time program
10 managers, training classes, exercise workshops, and the
11 purchase of non-capital office supplies and operating
12 supplies. The assistance arrangement for this program is
13 on a Cost Reimbursement basis.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the RCPGP is to build
15 state and local capacity to manage catastrophic incidents by
16 improving and expanding regional collaboration for catastrophic
17 incident preparedness. The FY 2019 RCPGP requires grant recipients
18 to develop and deliver one project that builds capability to
19 address a gap in the Logistics and Supply Chain Management core
20 capability. The City submitted a proposal to fund a three-year
21 project titled "Regional Logistics and Supply Chain Management
22 (RLSCM) Resilience Initiative Project (the "Project"). The Project
23 will identify systemic regional vulnerabilities and
24 interdependencies and facilitate development of plans and
25 mitigation strategies to fortify the regional logistic supply
26 chain. In addition, the Project will provide a significant
27 investment in human capital within the region by providing skills
28 and training and enabling certifications that support the core
29 capability of Logistics and Supply Chain Management. The purpose of
30 the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for two full-
31 time RCPGP managers through September 30, 2022, contractual costs

1 for course delivery of 12 FEMA courses, contractual costs for
2 exercise design and development, fringe and travel costs for the
3 salaried employees, and the purchase of non-capital office supplies
4 and operating supplies. The grant period is from October 1, 2019,
5 through September 30, 2022.

6 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
7 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary
8 are hereby authorized to accept, for and on behalf of the City, the
9 RCPGP Award Documents between the U. S. Department of Homeland
10 Security and City of Jacksonville, in substantially the same form
11 placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

12 **Section 4. Oversight.** The City of Jacksonville
13 Emergency Preparedness Division will provide oversight.

14 **Section 5. Approval of Positions.** There are hereby
15 approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-093,
16 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
17 reference.

18 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
