RESOLUTION REGARDING RESPONSES Α TO THE COUNCIL AUDITOR; URGING THE INDEPENDENT THE CONSOLIDATED AUTHORITIES OF CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO ADOPT A POLICY DIRECTIVE TO PROVIDE FOR A PROCESS TO RESPOND TO REQUESTS MADE BY THE COUNCIL AUDITOR, SIMILAR TO THE JACKSONVILLE'S EMPLOYEE CITY OF **SERVICES** DIRECTIVE - 0534; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 5.10 of the Charter of the City of Jacksonville empowers the Council Auditor to request certain financial information from various offices and departments of City government including independent authorities and other agencies and entities of City government as described therein; and

WHEREAS, the Charter does not prescribe a process in which those parties acknowledge receipt of a request by the Council Auditor or a timeframe for providing an estimate of the time required to fulfill such request; and

WHEREAS, ordinances are pending (Ordinances 2020-40 and 2020-39) which would create a process in Article 21 (JEA), City Charter, and Chapter 50 (Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, for JEA and boards and commissions created by ordinance so that a uniform procedure is in place for boards and commissions to communicate and

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timely comply with the Council Auditor's requests for information; and

WHEREAS, for other independent authorities created in the Jacksonville Charter and those created by legislative act, a referendum or act of the Legislature may be required in order to mandate adherence to such process; and

WHEREAS, after these bills were filed, the Executive Branch adopted Employee Services Directive - 0534 which provides guidance to all City employees regarding the process for communication with the requests of the Council Auditor, which is substantially similar to the language in Ordinance 2020-39 and 2020-40, a copy of the Directive is attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that it would be in the best interests of the consolidated government for the independent authorities to adopt a policy or directive similar to Employee Services Directive-0534; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Policy or Directive regarding Responses to the Council Auditor. The Council hereby urges the independent authorities of the consolidated government of Jacksonville to adopt a policy or directive in similar form to Employee Services Directive - 0534, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, which would provide a uniform procedure for independent authorities and their boards to communicate and timely comply with the Council Auditor's requests for information.
