Section 1. Amending Chapter 154 (Alcoholic Beverages),
Section 154.103 (Female employees mingling with patrons), Ordinance
Code. Chapter 154 (Alcoholic Beverages), Section 154.103 (Female
employees mingling with patrons), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended
to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 154 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES)

Section 154.103. Female employees mingling with patronsReserved.

It shall be unlawful and a class D offense for any female employee of a licensed business authorized to dispense alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises to drink, dance or mingle with any patron of such establishment. Reserved.

Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the

emergency is that women regulated by this ordinance are subject to 1 2 immediate enforcement of this prohibition and are subject to a 3 \$500.00 fine for each time a violation occurs. Section 3.
