5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
6 MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND
7 DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, A
8 ROADWAY TRANSFER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
9 JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
10 TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) TRANSFERRING FROM THE
11 STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO THE CITY A RIGHT-OF-
12 WAY KNOWN AS STATE ROAD 109/UNIVERSITY
13 BOULEVARD (ROADWAY ID 72110000) (THE "ROADWAY")
14 AND THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE OPERATION,
15 MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF THE ROADWAY;
16 PROVIDING FOR RECORDING OF EXISTING RIGHTS-OF-
17 WAY MAPS IN THE PUBLIC LAND RECORDS BY THE
18 CITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Roadway Transfer Agreement Approved.** There
22 is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are
23 hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the
24 City of Jacksonville, the Roadway Transfer Agreement between State
25 of Florida Department of Transportation and the City of
26 Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida (the "Agreement"), in
27 substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**. FDOT owns
28 a certain right-of-way located within the corporate limits of the
29 City and known as State Road 109/University Boulevard (Roadway ID
30 72110000) (the "Roadway"), commencing at milepost 1.688 and
31 extending to milepost 2.266, as more particularly shown on the
32 concept map attached to the Agreement as Exhibit A, and the right-

1 of-way maps attached to the Agreement as Exhibit B. The Agreement
2 transfers from the State Highway System to the City of Jacksonville
3 the Roadway and the responsibility for the operation, maintenance,
4 and repair of the Roadway, including the actual roadbed, together
5 with the right-of-way and all bridges, railroad crossings, curbs,
6 culverts, drainage structures, sidewalks, bike paths, traffic
7 control devices, utilities, street lights, overhead truss signs,
8 and other improvements located within the Roadway. Upon completion
9 of the transfer, the City shall own, operate, maintain, and repair
10 the Roadway and all improvements therein. The Agreement also
11 provides for the recording of existing rights-of-way maps in the
12 public land records by the City.

13 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
