5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,880,120.00 FROM  
6 THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE INTO THE KIDS HOPE  
7 ALLIANCE SUBFUND TO FUND PROGRAMS AND SERVICES  
8 FOR AT-HOPE CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN  
9 JACKSONVILLE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-064;  
10 INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION 126.107(G)  
11 (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS),  
12 CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE*  
13 *CODE*, REGARDING CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAM  
14 CONTRACTS TO BE PROVIDED BY PROVIDERS  
15 SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE  
16 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION  
17 SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER  
18 OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND  
19 DELIVER CHILDREN'S SERVICES CONTRACTS WITH  
20 PROVIDERS SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE; WAIVING  
21 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(a)  
22 (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE  
23 ALLIANCE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO EXEMPT  
24 CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING TO BE PROVIDED  
25 BY PROVIDERS SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE FROM  
26 COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING AN  
27 EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
31 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

1 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
2 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

9 (c) Explanation of appropriation

10 The funding above is an appropriation of \$1,880,120 from  
11 the general fund balance into the Kids Hope Alliance  
12 subfund.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
14 this ordinance is to fund programs and services for at-hope  
15 children and youth in Jacksonville, as listed on the First Revised  
16 2019-511-E Schedule M, a copy of which is attached hereto as  
17 **Exhibit 2.** The following funds will be made available to be  
18 awarded to providers under Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*: (i) \$421,389  
19 will be made available under KHA's ESC-0210-20 for Juvenile Justice  
20 Prevention & Intervention Programs; (ii) \$577,664 will be made  
21 available under KHA's ESC-0218-20 for Special Needs Programs and  
22 Services; and (iii) \$402,308 will be made available under KHA's  
23 ESC-0212-20 for Preteen and Teen Programs. In addition, \$478,759  
24 will fund the providers listed in **Exhibit 3** for the programs shown  
25 in **Exhibit 3.**

26 **Section 3. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**  
27 **Ordinance Code.** The Kids Hope Alliance is hereby authorized to  
28 procure children's services from the providers listed and in the  
29 contract amounts shown in **Exhibit 3**, attached hereto and  
30 incorporated herein by this reference. Pursuant to Section  
31 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126

1 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such services are exempted from  
2 competitive solicitation because the children's services to be  
3 provided by the specified providers are being appropriated and  
4 approved in this authorizing legislation.

5 **Section 4. Approval and authorization to execute.** The  
6 Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief  
7 Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby  
8 authorized to execute contracts with the children's services  
9 providers listed in **Exhibit 3** for the children's services programs  
10 shown in **Exhibit 3** and appropriated and authorized in Sections 1  
11 and 3 above.

12 **Section 5. Waiver of the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids**  
13 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts).** The City  
14 hereby waives the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance),  
15 Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts) with respect to the contracts  
16 approved and authorized under Section 3 of this Ordinance. Section  
17 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be  
18 competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. The  
19 waiver is needed in order to allow the Kids Hope Alliance to  
20 expeditiously provide these children's services without the delay  
21 involved in a competitive procurement.

22 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
