5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE
6 AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA
7 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR
8 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN
9 THE DESIGN AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT OF
10 PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON PARK
11 STREET/MARGARET STREET FROM RIVERSIDE AVENUE
12 TO THE I-95 RAMPS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-
13 054; AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
14 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
15 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT
16 ENTITLED "PARK ST. PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS
17 FROM RIVERSIDE AVE TO I-95 RAMPS"; AUTHORIZING
18 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE
19 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER,
20 FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE LOCAL
21 AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN FDOT AND THE
22 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY
23 OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION
24 MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
25 PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
29 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
30 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
31 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

8 The funding above comprises grant funds from the Florida
9 Department of Transportation (FDOT) for reimbursement of
10 the City's participation in the design and project
11 management of Pedestrian Improvements on Park
12 Street/Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the I-95
13 ramps.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this legislation is
15 to appropriate grant funds from FDOT for reimbursement of the
16 City's participation in the design and project management of
17 Pedestrian Improvements on Park Street/Margaret Street from
18 Riverside Avenue to the I-95 ramps to add raised sidewalks, upgrade
19 existing crosswalks, and re-time signal controls.

20 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the
21 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and
22 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to use grant
23 funds for the project entitled "Park St. Pedestrian Improvements
24 from Riverside Ave to I-95 Ramps." The project is more fully
25 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as
26 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council
27 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next
28 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best
29 interests of the community because such deferral could result in
30 the City's losing valuable grant dollars. Pursuant to Section
31 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires

1 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present
2 at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this
3 section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance
4 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital
5 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue
6 in full force and effect.

7 **Section 4. Approving and authorizing execution of FDEP**
8 **Standard Grant Agreement.** The Mayor, or his designee, and
9 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
10 for and on behalf of the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement
11 between FDOT and the City of Jacksonville, in substantially the
12 same form placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

13 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Engineering and Construction
14 Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide
15 oversight.

16 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
18 without the Mayor's signature.
