ORDINANCE 2020-208

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE \$5,000.00 FROM AMOUNT OF THE FLORIDA OF TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT (FDOT) FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE DESIGN AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON PARK STREET/MARGARET STREET FROM RIVERSIDE AVENUE TO THE I-95 RAMPS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-054; AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "PARK ST. PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS FROM RIVERSIDE AVE TO I-95 RAMPS"; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN FDOT AND THE JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above comprises grant funds from the Florida

Department of Transportation (FDOT) for reimbursement of

the City's participation in the design and project

management of Pedestrian Improvements on Park

Street/Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the I-95

ramps.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this legislation is to appropriate grant funds from FDOT for reimbursement of the City's participation in the design and project management of Pedestrian Improvements on Park Street/Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the I-95 ramps to add raised sidewalks, upgrade existing crosswalks, and re-time signal controls.

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to use grant funds for the project entitled "Park St. Pedestrian Improvements from Riverside Ave to I-95 Ramps." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral could result in the City's losing valuable grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires

the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Approving and authorizing execution of FDEP Section 4. Standard Grant Agreement. Mayor, or his designee, The Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement between FDOT and the City of Jacksonville, in substantially the same form placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 5. Oversight. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide oversight.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become Section 6. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
