RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND Α HONORING JACKSONVILLE JUMBO SHRIMP GENERAL MANAGER HAROLD CRAW ON HIS PROMOTION TO THE POSITION OF EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT/GENERAL MANAGER, FOR CONTINUING TO KEEP THE JUMBO SHRIMP A VITAL ASSET TO THE JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY BY PROVIDING SAFE AND AFFORDABLE FAMILY FUN AT THE BALLPARK, AND FOR CONTINUING TO BE PILLAR OF THE COMMUNITY AND AN INSPIRATION TO OUR LOCAL YOUTH; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Harold Craw is a native of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Mr. Craw graduated from Emory and Henry College with a degree in Physical Education and earned a Master's Degree in Sport Management from East Tennessee State University in 2001. He started his Minor League Baseball career in 2002 with the Johnson City Cardinals as the Director of Stadium Operations. Mr. Craw spent more than ten seasons with the Charleston River Dogs from 2003 to 2012, twice being recognized by the South Atlantic League as Sales Executive of the Year. Mr. Craw was the General Manager of the Quad Cities River Bandits and a Senior Corporate Sales Executive, and later Assistant General Manager, of the Chattanooga Lookouts before being hired by Fast Forward Sports Group to lead the Jacksonville Suns; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Craw was named the General Manager of the Jacksonville Suns on September 17, 2015 when Fast Forward Sports

Group, LLC took ownership of the Southern League club. After helping the franchise draw nationwide attention following their 2016 rebrand changing the club's name from "The Suns" to "The Jumbo Shrimp", Mr. Craw oversaw an incredible 23 percent increase in attendance for the inaugural Jumbo Shrimp season in 2017, the largest increase for any Double-A club. The success carried over to the following campaign as the July 3, 2018 crowd of 11,762 was the largest home crowd in ten years; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Mr. Craw became the first African-American to win Executive of the Year for any league in Minor League Baseball. He was voted the 2017 Southern League Jimmy Bragan Executive of the Year by the general managers of the league's member clubs. In January 2020, he was promoted to Executive Vice President/General Manager of the Jumbo Shrimp franchise. In this capacity, Mr. Craw is currently the only African-American General Manager in Minor League Baseball and continues to be a pillar of diversity and progress in the sport. Outside of baseball, Mr. Craw has consistently been active in his local community including cofounding and co-chairing the Charleston RBI Baseball League and mentoring local middle school youth through Jacksonville's Duval County Public Schools' 5000 Role Models program; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby recognizes and honors Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp Manager Harold Craw for his promotion to the position of Executive Vice President/General Manager, for continuing to keep the Jumbo Shrimp a vital asset to the Jacksonville Community by providing safe and affordable family fun at the ballpark, and for continuing to be a pillar of the community and an inspiration to our local youth.
