**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates \$5,000 received from the Florida Department of Transportation as reimbursement for the City's participation in the design and project management of pedestrian improvements on Park and Margaret Streets from Riverside Avenue to the I-95 ramps in Riverside to XX, It amends the 2020-24 Capital Improvement Program to provide funding to the "Pedestrian improvements on Park and Margaret Streets from Riverside Avenue to the I-95 ramps" project. It authorizes the administration to execute a local agency program agreement between the City and FDOT for the project, and provides that the Engineering and Construction Management Division of Public Works will be the City's oversight agency for the project.

**Background Information:** The project in question provides for the development of plans for Pedestrian Safety Improvements on Park and Margaret Streets to add raised crosswalks, upgrade existing crosswalks, and re-time signal controls. The \$5,000 reimbursement from FDOT covers the cost of City personnel assigned to assist in the project's design.

Policy Impact Area: Pedestrian safety improvement

**Fiscal Impact:** The bill appropriates \$5,000 in reimbursement from the FDOT for City personnel costs incurred in the project design process.
