ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR ΑN DISCLAIMING A DRAINAGE AND UTILITIES EASEMENT ESTABLISHED IN THE MANDARIN MEADOWS UNIT 2 PLAT RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 29, PAGE 67 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6, AT THE REQUEST OF VC MANDARIN SENIOR HOUSING, LTD.; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Closure and Abandonment. Section 1. Α drainage and utilities easement established in the Mandarin Meadows Unit 2 Plat recorded in Plat Book 29, Page 67 of the Public Records of Duval County, in Council District 6, a description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as an easement at the request of VC Mandarin Senior Housing, Ltd. (the "Applicant"). There are no city, state, or utilities agencies objections to this abandonment request. Applicant has paid the easement abandonment with encroachment application fee of \$516.00, and this amount has deposited into the General Fund, PWRE011-34907 00111.152001.349070.000000.00000000.00000.

Applicant Section 2. Purpose. The constructed assisted living facility over the easement without knowing of the existence of the easement. The Applicant is requesting abandonment of the easement in order to establish clear title to the property.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the drainage and utilities easement is subject to the execution and delivery to the City by Applicant ("Grantor") of a hold harmless covenant in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the easement shall not be recorded in the Public Records until execution and delivery to the City by Grantor of the required hold harmless covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
