7 A RESOLUTION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 5.10,
8 CHARTER OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE,
9 APPOINTING KIM TAYLOR TO THE POSITION OF CITY
10 COUNCIL AUDITOR; PROVIDING FOR A PROSPECTIVE
11 EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR A RECOMMENDATION
12 FOR SALARY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **WHEREAS,** Kim Taylor holds a Bachelor of Business
15 Administration in Accounting and a Master of Accountancy Degree
16 from the University of North Florida and has been a certified
17 public accountant for over 24 years; and

18 **WHEREAS,** Ms. Taylor has been employed in the City Council
19 Auditor's Office since 1995 and has served as an Assistant Council
20 Auditor for the City since 2017; and

21 **WHEREAS,** Kim Taylor has made herself invaluable to the City
22 Council throughout his decades of service conducting audits,
23 analyzing legislation, reviewing and explaining budgets, and
24 otherwise providing advice and recommendations to the City Council,
25 its committees and members; and

26 **WHEREAS,** the Personnel Committee unanimously and highly
27 recommends Kim Taylor to be the sixth Council Auditor in the
28 history of consolidated government; now therefore

29 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council, pursuant to Section
31 5.10, Charter of the City of Jacksonville, hereby appoints Kim

1 Taylor to the position of City Council Auditor. A copy of Ms.
2 Taylor's resume is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

3 **Section 2. Prospective Effective Date.** This resolution
4 shall become effective June 27, 2020, due to a vacancy occurring by
5 the resignation of the current City Council Auditor effective June
6 26, 2020.

7 **Section 3. Recommendation for Salary.** Section 11.122
8 provides that the Personnel Committee shall bring to the Council
9 for Council Approval recommendations regarding salary ranges and
10 positions pertaining to all applicable City Council employee
11 positions. The Personnel Committee at its April 27, 2020 meeting
12 voted to recommend that Ms. Taylor's initial salary be set at
13 \$200,000.00 annually.

14 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
15 effective upon signature of the Council President and the Council
16 Secretary.
