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ORDINANCE 2020-240

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$175,591.52 FUNDS AWARDED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM) FOR FLOOD MITIGATION GRANT - MITIGATION RECONSTRUCTION OF REPETITIVE LOSS PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO DEMOLISH ONE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE AND CONSTRUCT A NEW ELEVATED STRUCTURE ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 10253 SHARK ROAD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32226, B.T. 20-045; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZED BY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FDEM AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE THE GRANT FUNDS AND TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT THEAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND DEMMI JO MURPHY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT'S DIVISION OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above was awarded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for Flood Mitigation Grant - Mitigation Reconstruction Repetitive Loss Property (the "Project"). The total estimated cost of the Project is \$208,635.42. The federal grant provides approximately 84.16% of the funding for the Project. The homeowner, Demmi Jo Murphy, must provide a 10% match, such match being \$33,043.90, or 15.84% of the total cost, a percentage resulting from the fact that FEMA will only pay \$150,000.00 in "construction costs," with the homeowner being responsible for construction costs in excess of \$150,000.00. The funding expires April 1, 2022.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for a mitigation reconstruction of one residential property located at 10253 Shark Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32226. The City will demolish one residential structure and construct a new elevated structure no more than 10% larger than the

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original structure at least one foot above the Base Flood Elevation.

Subaward and Grant Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City and the Florida Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services, and all other documents necessary to receive the grant funds described herein and to effectuate the purpose of this ordinance.

Assistance Grant Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Demmi Jo Murphy, a copy of which has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 5. Oversight. The Division of Emergency Preparedness of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
