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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the account listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above in the amount of \$552,683.00 comprises 3 annual Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding from the 4 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to 5 be administered pursuant to 24 CFR 576.100(c). The City 6 7 must obligate all funds, except for the amount designated for administrative costs, within 180 days after HUD signs 8 9 the grant agreement, and all funds must be expended 10 within 24 months after HUD signs the grant agreement.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 11 Section 1 is to provide funding to: i) engage homeless individuals 12 and families living on the street; ii) improve the number and 13 14 quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families; iii) help operate these shelters; iv) provide essential 15 16 services to shelter residents; v) rapidly re-house homeless individuals and families; and, vi) prevent individuals and families 17 from becoming homeless. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing 18 the proposed use of funds is attached hereto as $\ensuremath{\texttt{Exhibit}}\ 2$ and 19 20 incorporated herein by this reference.

21 Section 3. Additional authority. In the event a sub-22 recipient is unable or unwilling to accept an award of funds, the 23 funds shall be reallocated to the next eligible awardee using the 24 same method and criteria applied by the Commission.

25 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
