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ORDINANCE 2020-213-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,000,000.00 FROM THE TREE PROTECTION AND RELATED EXPENSES TRUST FUND, SUBFUND 15F (NOW FUND 15304), TO THE "LEVEL 3 TREE PLANTING PROGRAM," TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO BE ADMINISTERED BY PUBLIC WORKS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LEVEL 3 TREE PLANTING REQUIREMENTS; APPROVING, PROGRAM REQUESTING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OVERSEE AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM ΙN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CRITERIA HEREIN PROVIDED; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE AND CORPORATION MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER FROM TIME TO TIME HENCEFORTH A STANDARD AGREEMENT ENTERING INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THIRD PARTIES FOR THE LEVEL 3 TREE PLANTING PROGRAM NO FURTHER ACTION BY CITY REQUIRED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Tree Commission, an advisory body of the City of Jacksonville was formed to encourage and coordinate the efforts of the various public and private entities that are concerned with the conservation and enhancement of the City's tree canopy; and

WHEREAS, the Tree Commission established the "Level 3 Tree

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Planting Program," (the "Level 3 Program"), which allows entities to propose a tree planting project on public property that would be funded by the Tree Protection and Related Expenses Trust Fund and which would be designed, coordinated, purchased, installed and guaranteed by an entity other than the City; and

WHEREAS, to date, two Level 3 projects have been proposed and approved by the Tree Commission, the Mayor's Budget Review Committee and the City Council for a total sum of \$177,885.00; and

WHEREAS, the Tree Protection and Related Expenses Trust Fund, Subfund 15F, to be known as "Fund 15304", contained now \$14,872,606.00 overall as of March 27, 2020 for the purpose of planting trees to replace the tree canopy for the City which has been lost through the process of land development; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is well equipped to oversee and administer the Level 3 Tree Planting Program and providing funding in an amount that should be adequate for a one year time period is an efficient and effective use of elected official and City staff time, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

Explanation of the appropriation - The funding above is (C) to provide \$1,000,000.00 from the Tree Protection and Related Expenses Trust Fund, Subfund 15F (now Fund 15304), for the "Level 3 Tree Planting Program," (the "Level 3 Program") administered by the Department of Public Works.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$1,000,000.00 for entities that have applied for Level 3 Tree Planting Program funding to provide the design, coordination, purchase, installation and guarantee of a tree planting project on public property within Duval County. The process for administering the Level 3 Program shall be the following:

- applicant after notification to the District Council Member and a preliminary meeting with the Public Works Arborist and related staff to discuss the goals and objectives of the project. The current Level 3 Application and Application Instructions are available on line on the Tree Commission's webpage which may be found on the Department of Public Works webpage, City of Jacksonville, and may be changed in format, but in general will be in keeping with the process outlined in this legislation, and;
- (2) Completed applications are provided to the Public Works Arborist and related staff who then prepare a staff report regarding the project for use by the District Council Member, and the Tree Commission in their advisory recommendation to the Mayor's Budget Review Committee ("MBRC");
- (3) The Tree Commission reviews the proposed project at a Tree Commission public meeting and recommends either approval, approval with conditions, or denial of the project to MBRC;
- (4) Public Works then prepares the documents necessary to communicate to MBRC the Tree Commission's recommendation as well as the original submission by the applicant;

(5) If MBRC approves the project, or approves it with amendments as provided by the Tree Commission, the Office of General Counsel will prepare the Grant Agreement between the City and the applicant for execution by the parties;

- (6) If MBRC approves the project but makes new amendments, the applicant is responsible for generating the revised documents for submittal as Exhibits to the Grant Agreement, which the Office of General Counsel will prepare.
- (7) The Public Works Arborist and related staff shall coordinate with the applicant, now Contractor, regarding bid documents and bid reviews for the subcontractor that will purchase the material and install the project;
- (8) The Public Works Arborist and related staff will assure that the project is completed pursuant to the Grant Agreement.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Public Works Department shall oversee the Level 3 Program and projects as described herein. The trees that are planted, and any that are removed as part of the planting, shall be recorded electronically on Plan-it Geo, or its equivalent, and they shall note the species and size of each, as well as the date of planting or removal.

Section 4. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to subsequent fiscal years.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization of Form Agreement. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver from time to time henceforth the standard Level 3 Tree Planting Grant Agreement, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference, with no further action by Council required, so that entities other than the City may receive Tree Protection and Related Expenses Trust Fund monies to purchase,

install and guarantee new trees on the public lands within Duval 2 County in accordance with the Level 3 Tree Planting procedures. Section 6. Effective Date.
