Background Information: The funding of \$2,610,888 consists of an annual Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the HOPWA program. The HOPWA program is administered by the Housing and Community Development Division and was established to provide housing assistance and related supportive services for low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families.
