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ORDINANCE 2020-262

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; RENAMING THAT PORTION OF BONNEVAL EXTENDING FROM J. TURNER BUTLER BOULEVARD TO PHILIPS HIGHWAY TO "BENTLEY ROAD" IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 11; DIRECTING THELEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION, AND COORDINATION WITH 911 EMERGENCY, FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, THE POST OFFICE AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING ΑN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Addressing Section of the Planning and Development Department received a request from the applicant, Brickell Motors, LLC, to re-name Bonneval Road to "Bentley Road"; a copy of the application and receipt of payment are attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is currently constructing a new facility on Bonneval Road, and will be opening a new Bentley car dealership at the facility; and

WHEREAS, the applicant requests a street name change to identify with the new Bentley dealership; and

WHEREAS, the street name change from Bonneval Road to "Bentley Road" affects the address re-assignment of 10 property owners; and WHEREAS, on January 23, 2020, and pursuant to section 745.105,

 Ord. Code the Planning and Development Department mailed written notification of the proposed street name change from Bonneval Road to "Bentley Road" to 10 property owners assigned to the designated street name which notice requested the property owner's written approval or objection to the proposed street name change. A copy of the January 23, 2020 letters are attached as **Exhibit 2**; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2020, property owner, Mnar Real Estate Holdings, LLC, assigned to Real Estate Number 152594 8160, indicated consent to the street name change. A copy of the written consent is attached as Exhibit 3; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2020, property owner, Jack Jasz, Inc., assigned to Real Estate Number 152594 8195, indicated an objection to the street name change. A copy of the written objection is attached as Exhibit 4; and

WHEREAS, the remaining 8 property owners failed to respond to the Planning Department's January 23, 2020 letters seeking their consent or objection, therefore, pursuant to Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, the remaining 8 property owners are deemed to have consented to the street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Addressing Staff invited the applicant and the property owners to the February 5, 2020 public meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee in order to participate in the discussion regarding the "Bentley Road" street name change request; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2020, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee determined and voted to approve the proposed street name change to "Bentley Road." An excerpt of the minutes of the February 5, 2020 meeting are attached hereto as Exhibit 5; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2020, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission reviewed the street name request, and recommended to change Bonneval Road to "Bentley Road"; a copy of

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WHEREAS, a copy of the map of "Bonneval Road" is attached

Preservation Commission are attached hereto as Exhibit 6; and

the recommendation and the minutes of the Jacksonville Historic

hereto as **Exhibit 7**; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it appropriate to change the referenced portion of Bonneval Road to "Bentley Road"; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Bonneval Road Renamed. Section 1. The street name of that portion of Bonneval Road extending from J. Turner Butler Boulevard to Philips Highway, in Council District 11, is hereby renamed "Bentley Road", by which name such street segment shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of the renamed "Bentley Road" is attached hereto as Exhibit 7.

Section 2. Directing Legislative Services to forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Section, for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the Post Office, Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering Division and other affected agencies and organizations.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
