Amending 2019-504-E, the FY 2019-2020 Budget Ordinance, to replace Revised Schedule B4b to allow for installation of the Stadium Improvements. 2019-504-E, the FY 2019-2020 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended to replace Revised Schedule B4b Capital Improvement Projects Funded Via Borrowing to add the Stadium Improvements thereto. The Second Revised Schedule B4b is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

Section 4. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies ("CIP"), is hereby amended to

add the \$5,800,000 in funding and the Stadium Improvements to the project entitled "Building Systems - TIAA Bank Field" (the "Project"). The Project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because the repairs are necessary to ensure safety and that the Stadium meets the minimum requirements to host NFL games for the 2020 NFL Season and other events. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires approval by a two-thirds vote of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. Except as amended herein, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Authorizing the Borrowing and Appropriation of Funds. The City is hereby authorized to borrow under its Commercial Paper Program and/or issue fixed-rate debt in the cumulative, maximum amount of \$5,800,000 and such funds are hereby appropriated to fund the Project.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
