COVID-19 Small Business Relief Grant Program

- Designed to assist small businesses located in Duval County to partially combat the economic impacts of the COVID-19 virus and encourage approved businesses to retain their employees for the duration of the declared emergency.
- City will make one-time payments of up to \$2,000 to approved applicants.
- The following types of businesses are generally, though not always, considered undesirable loans:
 - o Adult entertainment industry
 - o Amusement parks
 - Casinos and gambling establishments
 - o Dry cleaners locations with hazardous chemicals on-site
 - Marijuana/Cannabis related
 - o Meat packers/processors/slaughtering operations
 - Time-sharing and health club facilities
 - o Waste disposal firms/landfills/handlers of environmental contaminants
- Only one business Tax ID number will be permitted for these funds.
- Eligibility criteria include:
 - Must be located in Duval County;
 - Must have been in business for at least on (1) year from February 29, 2020;
 - Must have no more than 100 employees on February 29th 2020;
 - Must document number of employees as of February 29, 2020;
 - Must demonstrate that since February 29, 2020 the small business has experienced a reduction in revenue of 25% or more as a direct result of the COVID-19 crisis;
 - Must fill out and sign a W-9 form;
 - Must sign a certification that you have received the debit card;
 - An officer of the small business must sign an affidavit certifying the foregoing eligibility criteria.
