Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Fire Section 5. and Rescue Department shall provide oversight for the Agreement and Project.

Section 6. Requesting cycle emergency one passage pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that October 4, 2020, is National Fallen Firefighters Memorial Weekend and the Fallen Firefighters Memorial project needs to be completed prior to that date.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
