AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THEDESIGN AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT OF PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON PARK STREET/MARGARET STREET FROM RIVERSIDE AVENUE TO THE I-95 RAMPS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 20-054; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE THELOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM BETWEEN FDOT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT ΒY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
