6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE  
7 AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA  
8 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR  
9 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN  
10 THE DESIGN AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT OF  
11 PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON PARK  
12 STREET/MARGARET STREET FROM RIVERSIDE AVENUE  
13 TO THE I-95 RAMPS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED  
14 B.T. 20-054; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS  
15 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO  
16 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE  
17 CITY, THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT  
18 BETWEEN FDOT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;  
19 PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE  
20 ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT  
21 DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
27 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
28 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 20-054, May 18, -2020 - TEU"

6 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

7 The funding above comprises grant funds from the Florida  
8 Department of Transportation (FDOT) for reimbursement of  
9 the City's participation in the design and project  
10 management of Pedestrian Improvements on Park  
11 Street/Margaret Street from Riverside Avenue to the I-95  
12 ramps.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this legislation is  
14 to appropriate grant funds from FDOT for reimbursement of the  
15 City's participation in the design and project management of  
16 Pedestrian Improvements on Park Street/Margaret Street from  
17 Riverside Avenue to the I-95 ramps to add raised sidewalks, upgrade  
18 existing crosswalks, and re-time signal controls.

19 **Section 3. Approving and authorizing execution of FDEP**  
20 **Standard Grant Agreement.** The Mayor, or his designee, and  
21 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,  
22 for and on behalf of the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement  
23 between FDOT and the City of Jacksonville, in substantially the  
24 same form placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

25 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Engineering and Construction  
26 Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide  
27 oversight.

28 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
30 without the Mayor's signature.
