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Health and Human Services, Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Part A COVID-19 in order to provide HIV services responding to Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and related health and support services to persons living with HIV/AIDS and residing in the Transitional Grant Area composed of Duval, Nassau, Clay, and St. Johns Counties. No City match is required.

The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to enhance services during the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic by providing onetime funding to support preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19 as needs evolve for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program recipients, as outlined in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act. Pursuant to Office of Management and Budget Memorandum M2017, Administrative Relief for Recipients and Applicants of Federal Financial Assistance Directly Impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (COVIC-19), HRSA authorizes a recipient to incur pre-award costs prior to the effective date of a federal award dating back to January 20, 2020. Section 3. Oversight Department. The Social Services

Services shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 4. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is the need to provide services and meet the needs of clients in the current COVID-19 pandemic.
