5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN THE 6 THE 7 OF JACKSONVILLE AND CTTY BEACHES 8 CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU, INC., DOING 9 BUSINESS AS "VISIT JACKSONVILLE" TO ADMINISTER THE SPORTS TOURISM INITIATIVE APPROVED 10 ΙN ORDINANCE 2019-554-E, IN ACCORDANCE WITH TERMS 11 AND CONDITIONS AS APPROVED BY THE DUVAL COUNTY 12 TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL CONSISTENT 13 WITH THE PURPOSES OF ORDINANCE 2019-554-E; INVOKING 14 15 THE EXEMPTION IN 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE TDC; REQUESTING 16 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN 17 EFFECTIVE DATE. 18

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WHEREAS, the Duval County Tourist Development Council (the "Tourist Development Council" or "TDC"), pursuant to Chapter 70, *Ordinance Code*, administers the Tourist Development Plan set forth in Chapter 666, *Ordinance Code*; and

24 WHEREAS, the TDC at its regular meeting on May 28, 2020, 25 unanimously voted to recommend to the City Council to authorize the 26 Mayor, or his designee, to execute a services contract between the 27 City of Jacksonville and the Beaches Convention & Visitors Bureau, 28 Inc., doing business as "Visit Jacksonville" to administer the "Sports 29 Tourism Initiative" approved in Ordinance 2019-554-E, in accordance with terms and conditions approved by the TDC consistent with the 30 31 purposes of Ordinance 2019-554-E; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are 3 true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Approval and authorization to execute. 4 The 5 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby 6 authorized to execute a services contract, including any amendments 7 or renewals thereto, between the City of Jacksonville and the Beaches Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., doing business as 8 "Visit 9 Jacksonville" to administer the "Sports Tourism Initiative" approved 10 in Ordinance 2019-554-E, in accordance with the terms and conditions as approved by the TDC consistent with the purposes of Ordinance 11 2019-554-E. 12

Section 3. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into the services contract approved and authorized in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

20 Section 4. Oversight. The TDC shall oversee the funds 21 appropriated herein.

22 Section 5. Requesting one cycle emergency passage 23 pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency 24 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the 25 emergency is the change in Tourist Development Council membership at the end June 30, 2020, and need to expedite implementation of 26 27 the Sports Tourism Initiative pursuant to Ordinance 2019-554-E.

28 Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 30 without the Mayor's signature.
