1 2 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 3 Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, Section 1. 4 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 5 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 6 the account(s) listed in subsection (b): 7 (B.T. 20-045 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference) 8 9 (a) Appropriated from: 10 See B.T. 20-045 \$175,591.52 11 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 20-045 \$175,591.52 12 13 (C) Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above was awarded by the Federal Emergency 14 15 Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) 16 for Flood 17 Mitigation Grant - Mitigation Reconstruction of Repetitive Loss Property (the "Project"). 18 The total estimated cost of the Project is \$208,635.42. The federal 19 20 grant provides approximately 84.16% of the funding for 21 the Project. The homeowner, Demmi Jo Murphy, must provide 22 a 10% match, such match being \$33,043.90, or 15.84% of 23 the total cost, a percentage resulting from the fact that 24 FEMA will only pay \$150,000.00 in "construction costs," 25 with the homeowner being responsible for construction 26 costs in excess of \$150,000.00. The funding expires April 27 1, 2022. 28

28 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 29 Section 1 is to provide funding for a mitigation reconstruction of 30 one residential property located at 10253 Shark Road, Jacksonville, 31 Florida 32226. The City will demolish one residential structure and

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1 construct a new elevated structure no more than 10% larger than the 2 original structure at least one foot above the Base Flood 3 Elevation.

Section 3. authorizing Federally-Funded 4 Approving and 5 Subaward and Grant Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby 6 7 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City 8 9 and the Florida Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which 10 has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services, and all other documents necessary to receive the grant funds 11 12 described herein and to effectuate the purpose of this ordinance.

Section 4. Approving and authorizing Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Demmi Jo Murphy, a copy of which has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services.

20 Section 5. Oversight. The Division of Emergency 21 Preparedness of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department shall 22 oversee the project described herein.

23 Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 25 without the Mayor's signature.
