5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20 AND EXHIBIT 4
6 OF ORDINANCE 2020-235-E REGARDING THE
7 TEMPORARY MORATORIUM AS TO CERTAIN
8 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT PLAN
9 REVIEWS FEES; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE
10 UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
11 DATE.
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13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Amending Section 20 and Exhibit 4 of Ordinance**
15 **2020-235-E.** Section 20 (Temporary Moratorium Imposed and Duration
16 of Moratorium as to certain Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department
17 Plan Reviews Fees imposed by Section 123.102 (Fees established),
18 Part 1 (In General), Chapter 123 (Public Fees) of Ordinance 2020-
19 235-E that waived the imposition of certain Jacksonville Fire and
20 Rescue Department Plan Reviews Fees is hereby amended to replace
21 Exhibit 4 to include the following five fire safety inspection fees
22 within the temporary moratorium as authorized by and in accordance
23 with Ordinance 2020-235-E: (i) Fire Safety Inspection Fees -
24 Routine Inspection - \$0.009 per sq. ft. up to a maximum of \$5,000;
25 (ii) Fire Safety Inspection - First Re-inspection - no charge;
26 (iii) Fire Safety Inspection - Second re-inspection - \$0.009 per
27 sq. ft. up to a maximum of \$5,000; (iv) Fire Safety Pre-inspection
28 - Property Assessment - \$65.00; (v) Annual Fire Safety Inspection -
29 Food Truck - \$65.00 (collectively, the "Fire Safety Inspection
30 Fees"). The temporary moratorium on the Fire Safety Inspection

1 Fees shall commence retroactive to the April 27, 2020 enactment
2 date of Ordinance 2020-235-E. The Revised Exhibit 4 to Ordinance
3 2020-235-E is attached
4 hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

5 **Section 2. Emergency Passage Upon Introduction Pursuant**
6 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage of this
7 legislation upon introduction is requested. The nature of the
8 emergency is that the negative health and economic impacts of
9 COVID-19 are ongoing and immediate economic assistance is needed to
10 maintain the viability of businesses and ease the financial needs
11 of the citizens of Duval County impacted by COVID-19.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
