Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the disbursement of \$16,548,162.10 from the \$20,000,000 CARES Act funds previously appropriated through Ordinance 2020-0235-E, to the Business Relief Grant program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 19 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. The Finance and Administration Department and Office of Economic Development will provide oversight. Emergency passage is requested due to the urgent financial needs associated with the COVID 19 pandemic.

Background Information: as elsewhere in the country, the citizens and businesses of Duval County are facing severe economic impacts stemming in part from national, state and local emergency measures and closures. The purpose of this legislation is to provide grant funds to local for profit and nonprofit organizations impacted financially by the COVID 19 pandemic. The economic relief to businesses in the City is intended to maintain the viability of such businesses and the employment of individuals, and maintain the City's tax base and revenues.
