ORDINANCE MAKING FINDINGS; GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF HRUSTIC BROTHERS, INC. FOR AN INITIAL CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CON) FOR HRUSTIC BROTHERS CLEAN DEBRIS RECYCLING FACILITY; PROVIDING CONDITIONS OF SAID CERTIFICATE; INCORPORATING EXHIBITS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 380, Ordinance Code, Brothers, Inc. Making findings. Based upon the criteria Section 1. set forth in Section 380.105, Ordinance Code, the Council finds that the Facility would serve the public convenience and provide a needed service to the citizens of Duval County.

Section 2. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) granted. In accordance with Chapter 380, Ordinance Code, the City of Jacksonville hereby grants an initial Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) to Hrustic Brothers, Inc. to operate the Facility, as described in the attached Exhibit 1 and as described in the submitted and approved application.

Section 3. Conditions. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be subject to the conditions set forth in the "Hrustic Brothers, Inc. 139 Edgewood Avenue South Clean Debris Recycling Facility Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Specific Operating Conditions," attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1. The comments and recommendations of representatives of the Public Works Department, the Florida Department of Health, the Planning and Development Department, and the Environmental Quality Division are attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the CON Monthly Waste Analysis Reporting Form is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
