5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$237,088.00 FROM  
6 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE  
7 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, CONTINGENCY, AND  
8 PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR AND  
9 UPGRADE OF BRIDGE 724407 ON HODGES BOULEVARD,  
10 AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-089; AMENDING THE  
11 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
12 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO  
13 REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED  
14 "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE-BRIDGES"  
15 AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED  
16 "HODGES BOULEVARD BRIDGE UPGRADES"; PROVIDING  
17 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
22 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
23 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

31 The funding above is from Debt Management Fund Loan

1 Proceeds for the construction, contingency, and personnel  
2 costs associated with the repair and upgrade of Bridge  
3 724407 on Hodges Boulevard.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
5 Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida  
6 Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on  
7 Bridge 724407 on Hodges Boulevard and thus provide the driving  
8 public with traffic railing that will better prevent errant  
9 vehicles from breaking through the railing and crashing into the  
10 creek. The asphalt at the approaches to the bridge is damaged and  
11 needs to be repaired. The repair items associated with this project  
12 constitute safety upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge  
13 guardrail and pedestrian barriers.

14 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
15 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
16 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
17 reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection  
18 IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled  
19 "Hodges Boulevard Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more fully  
20 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as  
21 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council  
22 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next  
23 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best  
24 interests of the community because such deferral will result in  
25 unnecessary delay in repairing critical transportation  
26 infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
27 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
28 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
29 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
30 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other  
31 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by

1 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

2           **Section 4.           Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
4 without the Mayor's signature.
