6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$168,375.00 FROM
7 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE
8 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, CONTINGENCY, AND
9 PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR AND
10 UPGRADE OF BRIDGE 724085 ON ORCHARD STREET, AS
11 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-086; AMENDING THE 2020-
12 2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
13 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO REDUCE
14 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "COUNTYWIDE
15 INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE-BRIDGES" AND PROVIDE
16 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "ORCHARD
17 STREET BRIDGE UPGRADES"; PROVIDING AN
18 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
23 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
24 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

31 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

1 The funding above is from Debt Management Fund Loan
2 Proceeds for the construction, contingency, and personnel
3 costs associated with the repair and upgrade of Bridge
4 724085 on Orchard Street.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida
7 Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on
8 Bridge 724085 on Orchard Street and thus provide the driving public
9 with traffic railing that will better prevent errant vehicles from
10 breaking through the railing and crashing into the creek. The
11 asphalt at the approaches to the bridge is damaged and needs to be
12 repaired. The repair items associated with this project constitute
13 safety upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge guardrail and
14 pedestrian barriers.

15 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being
16 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
17 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
18 reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection
19 IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled
20 "Orchard Street Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more fully
21 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as
22 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council
23 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next
24 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best
25 interests of the community because such deferral will result in
26 unnecessary delay in repairing critical transportation
27 infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,
28 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
29 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the
30 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall
31 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other

1 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by
2 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

3 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5 without the Mayor's signature.
