8 GRANT PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA
9 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, AS INITIATED
10 BY B.T. 20-076; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
11 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
12 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
13 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE HAZARD MITIGATION
14 GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER H0336 BETWEEN
15 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA
16 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING
17 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION
18 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;
19 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
20 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
21 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT
22 ENTITLED "PRE TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY
23 GENERATOR REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
24 DATE.
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26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
28 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
29 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
30 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

6 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

7 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency
8 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation
9 GRant Program and approved by the Florida Division of
10 Emergency Management.

11 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
12 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation
13 of a permanent generator at the Pre Trial Detention Center. The
14 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce
15 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe
16 weather or other hazards.

17 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
18 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
19 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
20 behalf of the City, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract Number
21 H0336 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of
22 Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed **ON FILE** with
23 the Office of Legislative Services.

24 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division
25 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project
26 described herein.

27 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being
28 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
29 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
30 provide funding for the project entitled "Pre Trial Detention
31 Facility Generator Replacement." The project is more fully

1 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as
2 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council
3 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next
4 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best
5 interests of the community because such deferral will result in the
6 City's loss of needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section
7 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires
8 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present
9 at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this
10 section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance
11 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital
12 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue
13 in full force and effect.

14 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
