RESOLUTION 2020-374

A RESOLUTION URGING THE SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANNING COUNCIL (SEPPC) TO DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR DETERMINING ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL BASED ON THE NATURE OF AN EMERGENCY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has and will from time to time declare emergencies; and

WHEREAS, hurricanes and storms are not unusual to Floridians and numerous emergencies have been declared by the Governor and Mayor for these events; and

WHEREAS, the world pandemic of COVID-19 has been the nature of the most recent emergency declaration; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Municipal code provides that the City be prepared for these events and has set forth an emergency preparedness plan; and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of the most recent unprecedented Pandemic, there was uncertainty among the workforce as to essential and non-essential workers; and

WHEREAS, each emergency dictates essential personal, which can differ depending on the emergency; and

WHEREAS, at the height of the emergency is not the time to establish who is essential personnel; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Encouraging Development of Guidelines. The Council hereby urges the Security and Emergency Preparedness Council to develop clear guidelines on which personnel are

essential personnel for specific emergencies. Furthermore, the Council encourages SEPPC to consider language to be included in the Ordinance Code specific to determining required personnel for designated emergencies. Clear guidance will provide expectations to the workforce and departments, and allow for prudent expenditure of funds and formulation of budgets.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
