Small Businesses Reimbursement Assistance Program For Deep Cleaning and Sanitization

- Designed to provide financial assistance and reimbursement to small businesses which, after the state-wide reopening of businesses on May 4, 2020, closed temporarily and incurred costs to deep clean and sanitize the building or premises after an employee or customer tested positive for COVID-19.
- These funds can be used for the reimbursement of the costs and expenses associated with deep cleaning and sanitization of the building or premises. 0.
- The City will make a onetime reimbursement payment of up to \$10,000.
- Eligibility criteria include:
 - Must have a small business in Duval County at which employees work.
 - Must have demonstrated at least one (1) year in operations and provide most recent year's filed tax returns for the business and all owners.
 - o Must have between 2 and 100 employees in addition to the business owner.
 - Must demonstrate a financial impact of costs incurred from deep cleaning and sanitization which occurred after May 4, 2020 and on or before November 1, 2020 due to an employee or customer testing positive to COVID-19.
 - o The applying small business must own the building or represent that the business is responsible for the deep cleaning and sanitization of the premises.
 - Only one small business application per address.
 - o Must provide copies of receipts documenting costs for the deep cleaning and sanitization.
 - o The costs for the deep cleaning and sanitization must not have otherwise been mitigated/covered by insurance or any other third parties. The small business will have to attest that they have not and will not seek additional contribution for amounts reimbursed by the City under this Program.
