7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$283,392.00 FROM THE  
8 U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES  
9 RYAN WHITE HIV/AIDS PROGRAM PART A COVID-19  
10 RESPONSE TO PROVIDE HIV SERVICES RESPONDING TO  
11 CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND RELATED  
12 HEALTH AND SUPPORT SERVICES TO PERSONS LIVING  
13 WITH HIV/AIDS AND RESIDING IN THE JACKSONVILLE  
14 TRANSITIONAL GRANT AREA (TGA), AS INITIATED BY  
15 B.T. 20-074; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY  
16 THE SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT  
17 OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES;  
18 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;  
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation Authorized.** For the 2019-2020  
23 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated  
24 the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the  
25 account listed in subsection (b):

2 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

3 The funding above is a grant from the U. S. Department of  
4 Health and Human Services, Health Resources & Services  
5 Administration (HRSA) for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program  
6 Part A COVID-19 Response in order to provide HIV services  
7 responding to Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and  
8 related health and support services to persons living  
9 with HIV/AIDS and residing in the Transitional Grant Area  
10 composed of Duval, Nassau, Clay, and St. Johns Counties.  
11 No City match is required.

12 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
13 Section 1 is to enhance services during the coronavirus disease  
14 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic by providing onetime funding to support  
15 preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19 as needs  
16 evolve for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program recipients, as outlined in  
17 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act. Pursuant to  
18 Office of Management and Budget Memorandum M-20-17, Administrative  
19 Relief for Recipients and Applicants of Federal Financial  
20 Assistance Directly Impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19),  
21 HRSA authorizes a recipient to incur pre-award costs prior to the  
22 effective date of a federal award dating back to January 20, 2020.  
23 The Grant Budget Year is April 1, 2020, through March 31, 2021. A  
24 copy of the Notice of Award from HRSA is attached hereto as **Exhibit**  
25 **2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

26 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Social Services  
27 Division of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community  
28 Services shall oversee the project described herein.

29 **Section 4. Requesting one cycle emergency passage**  
30 **pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency  
31 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the

1 emergency is the need to provide services and meet the needs of  
2 clients in the current COVID-19 pandemic.

3       **Section 5.       Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
5 without the Mayor's signature.
