Section 2. Approval and authorization to execute.

Recitals.

The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute a services contract, including any amendments or renewals thereto, between the City of Jacksonville and the Beaches Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc., doing business as Jacksonville" to administer the "Sports Tourism Initiative" approved in Ordinance 2019-554-E, in accordance with the terms and conditions as approved by the TDC consistent with the purposes of Ordinance 2019-554-E.

Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g), Section 3. Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into the services contract approved and authorized in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(q), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight. The TDC shall oversee the funds appropriated herein.

Requesting Section 5. one cycle emergency pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of emergency is the change in Tourist Development Council membership at the end June 30, 2020, and need to expedite implementation of the Sports Tourism Initiative pursuant to Ordinance 2019-554-E.

This ordinance shall become Section 6. Effective Date. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
