Bill Summary: The bill appropriates a grant of \$10,000 from the Florida Department of Transportation for the state's participation in project management of design of the Intelligent Transportation System on Bay Street from I-95 to Festival Park Drive. Execution of a Local Agency Program Agreement between the City and FDOT is authorized and the Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works is designated as the City's oversight agency for the grant.

Background Information: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing plans for the installation of flood sensors, closed circuit television cameras, fiber optic cable, and associated components along Bay Street between 1-95 and Festive Park Drive in conjunction with the City's the BayJax (Bay Street Innovation Corridor) Project. The FDOT has agreed to provide reimbursement funding of up to \$10,000 for the City's participation in the design and management of the project.

Policy Impact Area: Bay Street Innovation Corridor construction

Fiscal Impact: The bill appropriates a grant of \$10,000 from the FDOT.
