Type of Action: Ordinance approving a change in polling place locations and emergency passage

Bill Summary: Pursuant to Section 352.102, *Ordinance Code*, this bill approves the change in polling place locations for precincts: 310, 607, 711, 713, 1101, 1104 and 1115. The location changes will be effective immediately for all special, primary and general elections. Emergency passage is requested due to the upcoming council holiday break and to ensure all changes are made in time for the August Primary Election.

Background Information: Four of the polling locations below are being relocated due to impacts of COVID-19, one due to fire damage and two due to more suitable locations. These precincts and polling place locations will be posted on in the Polling Place List in City Council and the Supervisor of Elections Office.
